5. Old Business

- a) Many dead fish have been seen floating in the Raritan River specifically near the boat launch area in Donaldson Park. These were identified as bunker fish and dead ones have also been reported in Edison and Red Bank. The cause is unknown but may be the result of oxygen depletion in the water.
- b) It was reported that light from the new Pulte development are shining into residences on Cleveland Avenue. Some of the lights are the globe type about 18 inches high. Need to look at the site plans and see if they match what was approved by the borough. If they don't conform, this situation should be referred to Code Enforcement.
